COMMITTEE REPORTS

LEGISLATIVE: Ian Dunleavy reported on Senate Bill 5197. It is sponsored by Senators Tom, Kohl-Welles, Kline, Fairey, Murray, Weinstein, Regala and Jacobsen. It relates to the sale of firearms at gun shows and events. It was referred to committees on labor, commerce, research & development. It would effectively prohibit the CMM annual gun show.

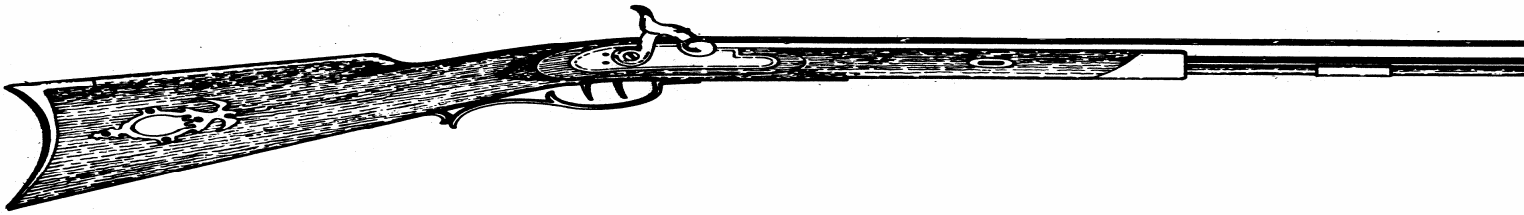
