Minutes of the Cascade Mountain Men March 7., 2007

Meeting was called to order at 8PM by president Greg Field. 22 members were present at the time. The minutes of the February meeting were accepted as published. Bud Maune raised a point of order regarding the treasurers bond amount. He asked for confirmation of the one million dollar amount. Lee Johnson was unable to attend the meeting. As a result, Bud's question remained unanswered.

No treasurers report was given, as Lee Johnson was absent.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

LEGISLATIVE: Senate Bill 5197 which could potentially eliminate our annual gus show, is out of committee. Ian Dunleavy urged everyone to contact their representative to vote against this bill. Ian also reported that Washington "Cease Fire" is trying to enact "piece-meal" legislation that would tighten Washington's gun laws in much the same way as in Massachusetts. Senate bill 6136 would give the wildlife commission the authority to raise fees by 10% every year.

WSMLA: The secretary was presented with a copy of the scheduled events for 2007. It is too extensive to be published in this newsletter however, it can be viewed on line at <http://www.wamuzzleloaders.org/events>.

RENDEZVOUS: King County is considering a "clean-up" of the Ravensdale site, due to lead deposits. John Abbott reported that the old clubhouse (trailer) may be available for free, as a new club house is under construction for the Seattle Trap and Skeet club. The Green River Mountain Men club is also interested in the Ravensdale site for a rendezvous. A lease could be obtained for 35 years.

RANGEMASTER: No report.

GUN SHOW: John noted that all tables are sold out. Discussion about the Washington Arms Collectors ensued. If CMM members want to buy any guns ther, you must be a member. Reminder that modern firearms are not allowed in our show. This is stipulated in our contract with the operators of the fair grounds. Only pre 1850's merchandize is allowed. Next year's show may include Civil War era merchandize. Merchants at the show will only be given 2 free passes per table.

The volunteer dinner will be held on April 14th at Barnabys at Southcenter, starting at 5 PM. (Note: the dinner date was listed incorrectly in the calendar of events in last month's news letter)

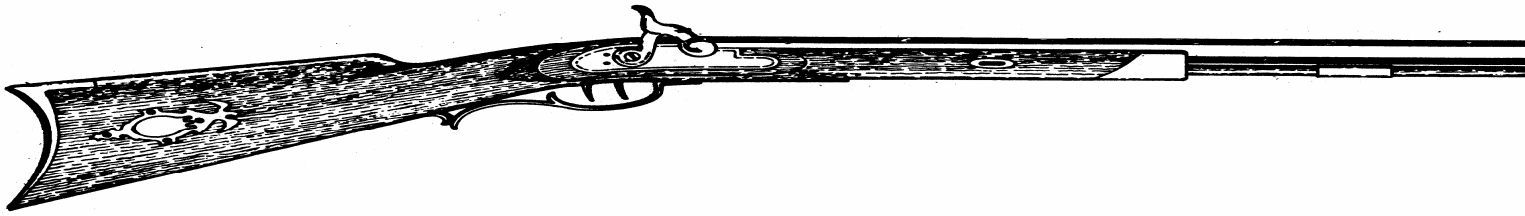
