Minutes of the Cascade Mountain Men April 10, 2007

Financial report from the gun show indicated 2118 people had attended the show. That was not including the income from the tables.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

LEGISLATIVE: Joe Schroeder reported that Senate Bill 5197 which could potentially eliminate our annual gun show, has been placed on hold for now. Proponents of this legislation (such as "Cease Fire") say that they will continue to try to force this legislation into law.

RENDEZVOUS: No report on the Ravensdale site for a rendezvous. Chuck Lacher reported that he has not heard back, regarding the lead reclamation at the site. 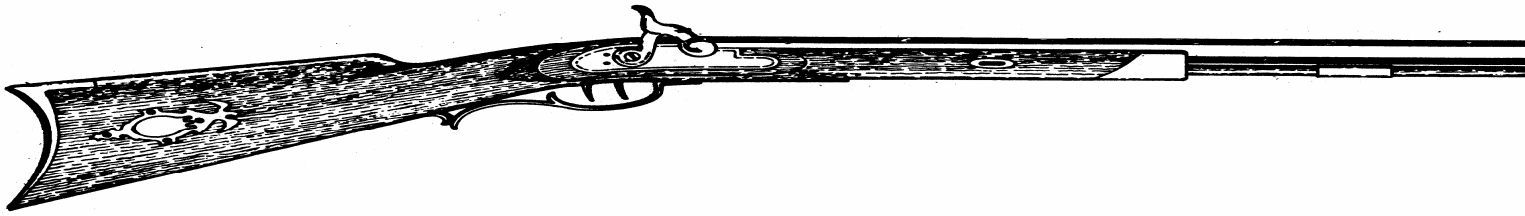
