Minutes of the Cascade Mountain Men October 11, 2007

COMMITTEE REPORTS

LEGISLATIVE: A memorandum was read from Walt Christiensen. It was in reference to the Washington State Fish & Game Department's definition of muzzleloaders. Greg stated that due to the number of in-line rifles in circulation, it will be very difficult to get the law to exclude them.

It was noted that the state of Florida had recently voted to exclude electronic ignition. It was noted that the State of Idaho allows for "side lock ignition" only.

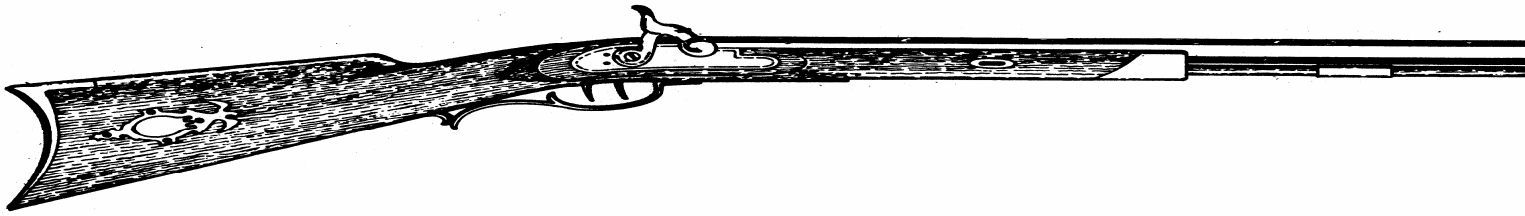
