**LEGISLATIVE:** Secretary read a fax from the Citizens Committee for the Right to Keep and Bear Arms in reference to HR 1022. A suggestion was made to make this committee a regular donation point for annual donations. Bob Bowman inquired as to what percentage of the money that is taken in by CCRKBA goes toward defense of our 2nd amendment rights and what percentage goes toward administration of their organization.

Goes is attempting to have the classification of black powder changed from an explosive 1.1 to 1.3 (DOT hazard classification) to bring about better availability and bring the price down.

**WSMLA:** John Abbott spoke with Walt Christenson regarding the black powder shotgun shoot that has been proposed at the Seattle Trap and Skeet range. It is to be held on the first weekend in September.

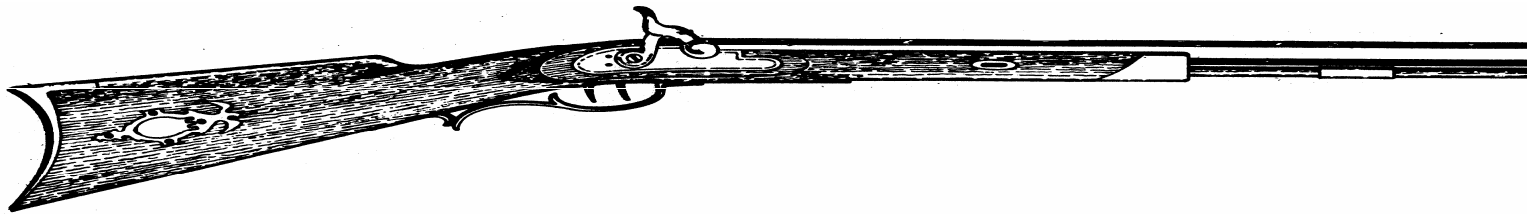
