LEGISLATIVE: There was a discussion about the City of Seattle and Mayor Greg Nichols attempt to ban concealed weapons on all city owned property. Ian Dunleavey stated that the State of Washington preempts Mayor Nichols ruling.

Walt Christenson stated that he had attended a meeting and that the Department of Ecology is attempting to introduce legislation banning all lead bullets, lead shot and lead wheel weights. This law did not get out of committee last year but will probably be introduced again this year. The state of Washington is trying to mimick the California law banning lead.

State of California recently stated a "green shoot," using bio-degradable birds and steel shot.

Club secretary reported that he has been receiving legislative information that should be disseminated out toe club members VIA E-mail as it is received.

Jerry Jazbec asked if anyone had information as to wether the range operators coalition is still an active organization.

WSMLA: Walt Christenson has been appointed to a Washington State range review committee, representing the interest of muzzle loaders.

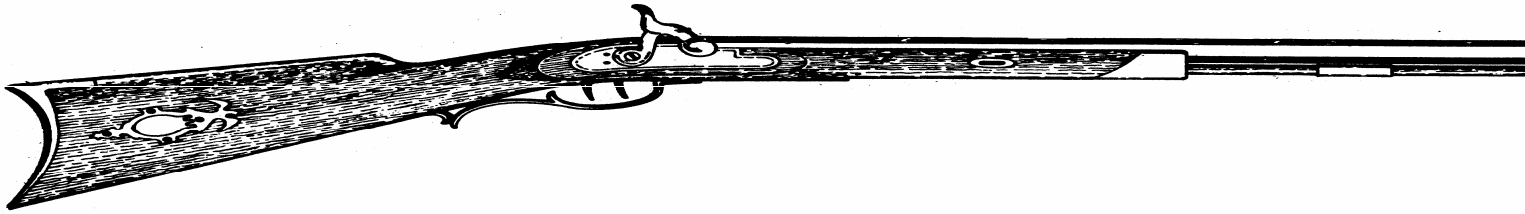
