Minutes of the Cascade Mountain Men July 10th, 2008

Meeting was called to order at 8:05 P.M. by President Greg Field. 13 members were present. The minutes of the June meeting were accepted following a correction to indicate that Greg Field is actually the club president.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer's report was accepted as reported by treasurer Lee Johnson. The executive committee has audited the club's financial records and find them to be in order. It was determined that approximately 5 to 6 thousand dollars of the club's income goes toward our monthly shooting program. This includes the club banquets. That is approximately half of our annual budget. Several thousand dollars go toward insurances, donations and other expenses. Lee is providing a copy of the report for the club's attorney. Lee also emphasized that the "shooters" really need to be involved in the gun show, as they benefit the most.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

LEGISLATIVE: There was a discussion on the C.A.P. (Chemical Action Plan) Report that had been received from Walt Christenson. Discussed input from Mike Mahlock and Doug Bennett as well. Mike's analysis was that this is simply a new method of trying to restrict our access to the materials for ammunition. Dug recommended that our shooting ranges be dedicated as repositories for the reclamation of lead. In this fashion, we will always have a place for depositing lead in the form of bullets.

Information regarding future hunting forecasts, to Washington State Fish & Game was discussed. WSF&G is requesting input for future licensing. If you are a hunter, please send your input to them regarding your future hunting/licensing hopes.

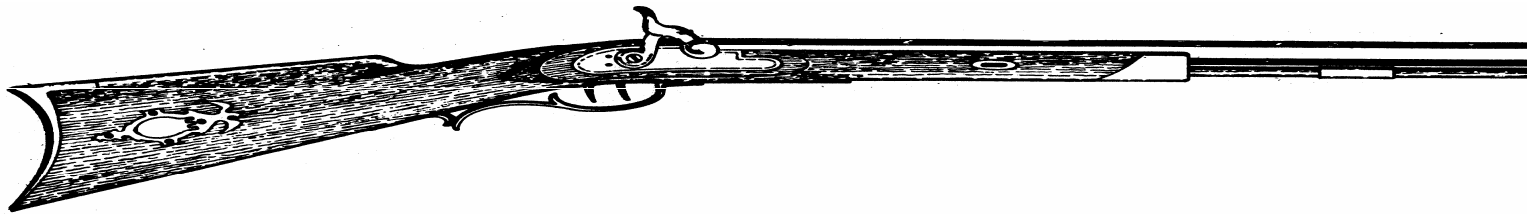
