**Minutes of the Cascade Mountain Men September 16th, 2008**

Meeting was called to order at 8:00 P.M. by President Greg Field. 12 members were present. The minutes of the August meeting were accepted as published in the newsletter.

Treasurer's Report: No report due to absence of treasurer. John Abbott suggested moving some of the club's money away from Washington Mutual due to their financial problems. This is due to limits of FDIC coverage. Greg recommended that we make it a policy that we not have any more than the insured limit in any single institution. John Recommended we consider a commercial savings bank. Joe Schroeder said that he would contact Lee regarding this move.

## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

### **LEGISLATIVE:**

Bud Maune reported that he has received a good report from the NRA on where Obama's money comes from and his hidden agenda. The NRA has endorsed Dave Richert for congressional re-election. Bud also reported on the state's chemical action plan (CAP) for the reduction of lead in the environment. He had attempted to contact the Puget Sound Angelers, as one of the "stake holders" within the CAP but had no success.

WSMLA: Their annual banquet is scheduled for the last Saturday in March 2009. Walt Christensen represents WSMLA in hunting allocations and has recently been appointed to a commission for grants to upgrade existing shooting ranges. He presented a number of issues related to hunting as well as WSMLA. There is an on-going survey being conducted by the Washington State Fish and Game commission. He also reported that muzzle loading hunters purchase 5 to 6 percent of the deer and elk tags. He stated that the state is considering an allocation formula for each game management areas that will reduce muzzle loaders down to that percentage of the total permits (tags) issued. He also stated that WSMLA committee members will be updating the state definitions for muzzle loaders. WSMLA is working on publication of a newsletter. RENDEZVOUS: John Abbott conducted a black powder shotgun shoot at the Green River mountain Men rendezvous. Turnout was low however it was a good event.

RANGEMASTER: No report from the meeting. Please note the new 5th match schedule. It will begin this month.

GUN SHOW: Our standard operating policies require a budget presentation for the upcoming show. Bud presented it as scheduled. It was accepted by the trustees present. The budget submitted was very similar to that of previous years. It was recommended that the club purchase radios (2-way communications) for the show, rather than to rent them each year. It may be a cost saving to the club. Because other rental items appear in the under radio rental expense budget line, it was difficult to make that determination. Vern indicated that the fence rental was included in this line item. The issue of radio purchase will be discussed in depth at the next meeting. We have 380 good addressees for vendor mailing and envelope stuffing. Remember that we will be stuffing envelopes at 7:00 P.M. on the 14th. We will order pizza and have soft drinks for those who show up for this fun work party. Remember - shooters benefit the most from the show profits. Hope to see all of you there. Bud said that he has received the contracts from muzzle loader for advertisement for next year's show. Jerry Jazbec reported that his scout crew will be available to help if needed. They will be requested formally.

LAND: Nothing new to report.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Registered Agent: Joe Schroeder reported no progress has been made in seeking a replacement.

Andy Reported that no progress had been made on the audit of the club's financial status because he is waiting for approval of the bid. It was moved /2/A to approve the bid and proceed on the audit.

John Abbott reported that no one has reported to him on the names that should appear on the award plaques for last year. He is still working on this. It was thought that Bruce Fisher should contact John regarding the names of the award recipients.

I reported on information received from Citizens Committee for Right to Keep and Bear Arms and Second Amendment Foundation. We have yet been unable to obtain a representative from that organization to speak to us regarding their activities and how our financial contribution would be spent. Decision to make a financial contribution to that organization is postponed until additional information can be obtained.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

I reported that our charter with the National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association has been renewed. NMLRA reported that of the members that I had listed on the renewal form, Bruce Fisher's membership had expired.

Vern Steward reported on reciprocity of concealed weapons permits. Please note that a complete list of carry licenses and reciprocal acceptance was included with our monthly newsletter about a month ago. That list was provided by the Citizens Committee and passed along as a part of our news letter. I will again provide this information.

John suggested that it is time for the trustees to consider the nomination of officers for 2009. The bylaws state that the slate of officer candidates must be presented by the November meeting. According to the bylaws, an officer may only hold the office for 2 years. Trustees however may be suspend the bylaws to allow officers to hold their office for periods exceeding 2 years. The trustees are choosing a representative to lead the selection of candidates. The slate of officers will be nominated by the next meeting.

Ted Fellowes reported that Dan Krell recently died. Dan is a former member of Cascade Mountain Men and past president. John Abbott reported that Bob Tresch has been having severe problems with an eye infection. He is on the recovery now however.

Laurie is (still) always searching for information for the newsletter for the Issaquah Sportsmen's club. She said that she could use articles related to black powder shooting.

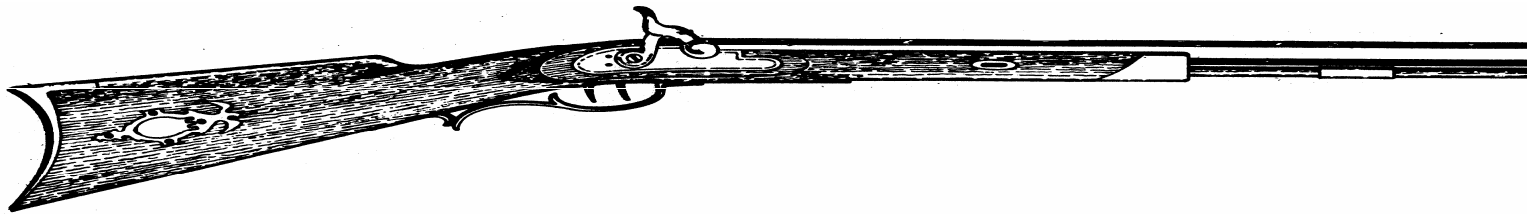
