Your first "Guest Visit" to a CMM shoot is free. For subsequent visits, a \$5 CMM non-member fee and \$10 ISC non-member daily range fee will apply. Meat prizes are awarded for First, Second and Third on all 6 of the targets. And, there is an aggregate prize for every shooter. The range is open to the general public at 23600 S.E. 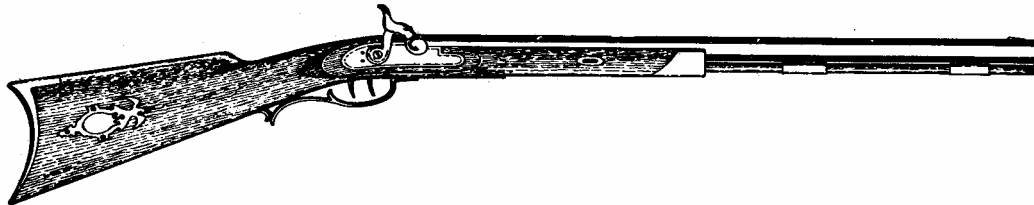

The Club has many resources; an extensive video library from which members and check out (free) videos on shooting, hunting, gun making, mountain man history, buck skinning crafts, etc. Members are also willing to teach muzzle loading shooting techniques and share shooting tips. Several members are involved in statewide muzzle loading activities, including input to the Fish & Game Commission on favorable muzzle loading hunting seasons.

The CMM also sponsors an annual Muzzle Loading Arms and Pioneer Crafts Show, the second week end in March. Held in Western Washington (see <http://www.cascademountainmen.org> for the current show announcement), this event is attended by thousands of muzzle loading enthusiasts every year, and traders come from as far away as Tennessee, Canada and most of the Western States to exhibit and sell at this well-known show.

Many of our members are dedicated buck skimmers and participate in many of the region's rendezvous throughout the year. We are well represented at regional and national events, with several medal winners being among our members. The club also puts together an informal hunting encampment every year during a late Elk or Deer muzzle loader season.
