Big news this month from President Bud Maune on the future of the CMM muzzle-loading gun show:

"The 2004 Gun Show is moving to the Evergreen State Fairgrounds in Monroe. In an Executive Committee meeting on April 9th, the Trustees voted to have the 2004 show and move the location to Monroe, WA.

"The fairgrounds at Monroe offers us a much more cost-effective venue, and it is still within reasonable driving distance for all of the membership to help support the show. Ted Fellowes reports that it is exactly the same mileage from his home in Seattle to either Enumclaw or Monroe.

"The show will occupy the Commercial Building and the Display Hall at the Evergreen State Fairgrounds. We will also have the Frontier Village area to place demonstrations and displays. It is not too early to start to consider who would be interested in putting

on a demonstration. The Fairgrounds is willing to have us exhibit an occupied camp. Any ideas you have you can get to Bud Maune. We will also need to designate a coordinator for this activity.

"We will be telling you a lot more about the 2004 show in future newsletters.

"Right now we are finalizing our contract with the Fairgrounds. We will be doing fliers next."

It was the first time since we left the Pacific Northwest that I have shot with a lot of competitive shooters. There aren't a lot of top-rate shooters here in the Yuma area. Guess I will have to go over to the Phoenix area more next winter. They had 48 shooters there for the championship, with 8 women shooting.

There will be a Santa Fe Trail Rendezvous June 8-15 there at Raton, if anyone is interested in coming down to it. If I order a whole case, I can get it for a more reasonable cost. They allow mixing grades in the case, so I'd likely get some 2fg and 3fg. Anyone want to go in on some Swiss powder? If so, contact me at the email or phone number listed in the box on page 1.

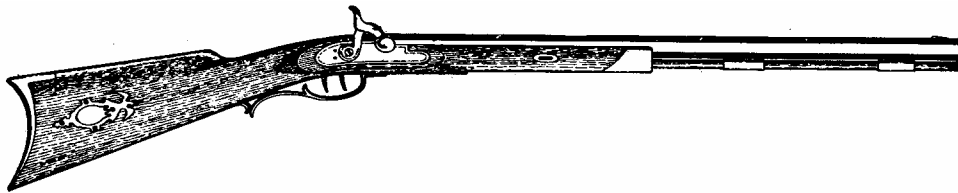
